

Tsuneishi Foundation repairs six classrooms through brigada eskwela



Tsuneishi Foundation (Cebu), Inc. (TFCI), the philanthropic arm of the Tsuneishi Group of companies, gathered approximately 300 employee-volunteers on May 31, 2014 for the group's annual corporate social responsibility (CSR) activity, the Brigada Eskwela 2014. (TAC), manufactures and export ship's furniture and general furniture for domestic market; and Cebu Asiatic Shipping & Port Services, Inc. (CASPI), engages in Domestic Shipping Business/Operations and thereby comply with the requirement of Maritime Industry Authority.
