It has always been my desire to work in a ship building company. For me, it is a conundrum that a massive structure (vessel) can stay afloat.

I have been with THI since March 21, 2012 and was first assigned as the Factory 2 blasting shop-in-charge where I was responsible for preparing painting schedules for the Blasting Shop/ Paint shop, attend daily meetings with the Planning group, Hull Outfitting group, and Transport Group, as well as coordinate with other groups for the schedule implementation. Later on, I switched roles as a Factory 2 paint-in-charge. My responsibilities include the preparation of block stage paint estimates before painting work starts for every vessel; check, monitor and verify paint material

withdrawals and consumptions, furnish weekly reports of the paint material consumption, and conduct weekly patrol as part of the Painting Reduction Activities. Other responsibilities include preparing ISO Documents, keeping of the Tripartite Agreement for each ship, preparing the Coating Technical Files (CTF) per ship and submitting the CTF to the Ship's Master after it has been approved by the Class NK.

One significant experience was when I helped improve our paint withdrawal procedure to where we could control the consumption and closely monitor the paint withdrawals. This modified withdrawal process prohibits the subcontractor from pulling out the paints directly from the purchasing warehouse as these can

only be ordered and delivered at the painting warehouse and may only be done by the painting-in-charge or the authorized painting warehouse clerk. Being able to make this contribution along with completing my assigned tasks, and contribute to the success of each (ship building) project makes me feel accomplished. My growth in this company is described by the initiative, determination, perseverance, and the competence to perform my responsibilities effectively and efficiently no matter what the project or position is. I consider it a personal endeavor to achieve impeccability in everything that I do. I find that every moment, even the ordinary ones, is filled with opportunities to experience, learn, and grow from. One just has to look past the surface and

think outside the box. I believe that one's values and principles plays an important role to become a notable employee. For me a THI employee is someone who is dedicated, responsible, driven, persistent, committed, steadfast, passionate, diligent, determined, hardworking, has integrity and a good judgement.

THI CLINIC CONDUCTS DENGUE SITE SURVEILLANCE



VIRUS ALERT

Balamban has the most of number dengue cases as it ranked 1st in the municipalities of Central Visayas with a total of 331 cases and one death from the period of January 1 to August 27, 2016 according to the Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance unit 7 (Central Visayas).

Responding to this outbreak, Tsuneishi Heavy Industries (Cebu), Inc. (THI), together with the local government unit of Buanoy conducted a dengue site surveillance inside the compound of the West Cebu Industrial Park-SEZ including all accommodation

facilities and offices. The campaign focuses on strengthening and intensifying dengue awareness to THI and subcontractor employees, as well as eradicating dengue-causing mosquitoes in the entire THI premises.



HERE ARE A FEW SIMPLE AND PRACTICAL TIPS TO KEEP DENGUE AT BAY:

#1: Turn over empty pails and buckets, so that they do not collect excess water. If the container that contains water cannot be emptied, remember to cover it well when not in use.

#2: Remember to clean out empty flower pots and not to over water potted plants. It is advised to not have any stagnant water around as it acts as breeding ground for the mosquitoes.

#3: Apply mosquito repellents on all exposed areas, during the day as well as at night on a regular basis to prevent dengue.

#4: Make sure your window and door screens do not have any holes. If so, block those areas properly to eliminate mosquitoes.

#5: Always cover your trash can or dustbin when not in use.

#6: Using camphor as a repellent also works wonders. Light camphor in a room and close all the doors and windows. Leave it this way for about fifteen to twenty minutes to have a mosquito free environment.
